- Find something that celebrates a milestone (for example: graduation, birthday or new baby)
- Find something that honors people who serve in the community
- Find a green leaf
- Find some acorns
- Find a piece of trash and pick it up – recycle or throw away
- Find a new bud on a bush
- Find a spider web
- Find a (non-human) mammal - squirrel, rabbit, dog, etc.
- Find a tree that is budding
- Find a work of art
- Find something purple
- Find some pinecones
- Find a brown leaf
